

There's an upcoming project in your area. Here's what you need to know.

2022 PRESERVATION ADA IMPROVEMENTS - GROUP 1

APRIL 2022

PROJECT

The 2022 Preservation ADA Improvements - Group 1 project will construct and upgrade sidewalk curb ramps at various locations in Clark County, in order to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act, or ADA, regulations.

This work includes constructing or reconstructing 24 ramps in the following areas:

- Nine locations on Northeast 50th Avenue
- Three locations on Northeast 80th Avenue
- Ten locations on Northeast 76th Street
- Two locations on Southeast Crown Road

SCHEDULE AND TRAFFIC

Construction is expected to begin in May and end in July 2022. For the safety of workers and the public, intermittent single-lane closures near project sites may be needed. Advanced notice will be given prior to any lane closures.

CONTRACTOR

The project will be completed by Clark and Son's Excavating, Inc., of Battle Ground.

FUNDING

The total project cost is approximately \$350,000, funded by the county's road fund.
